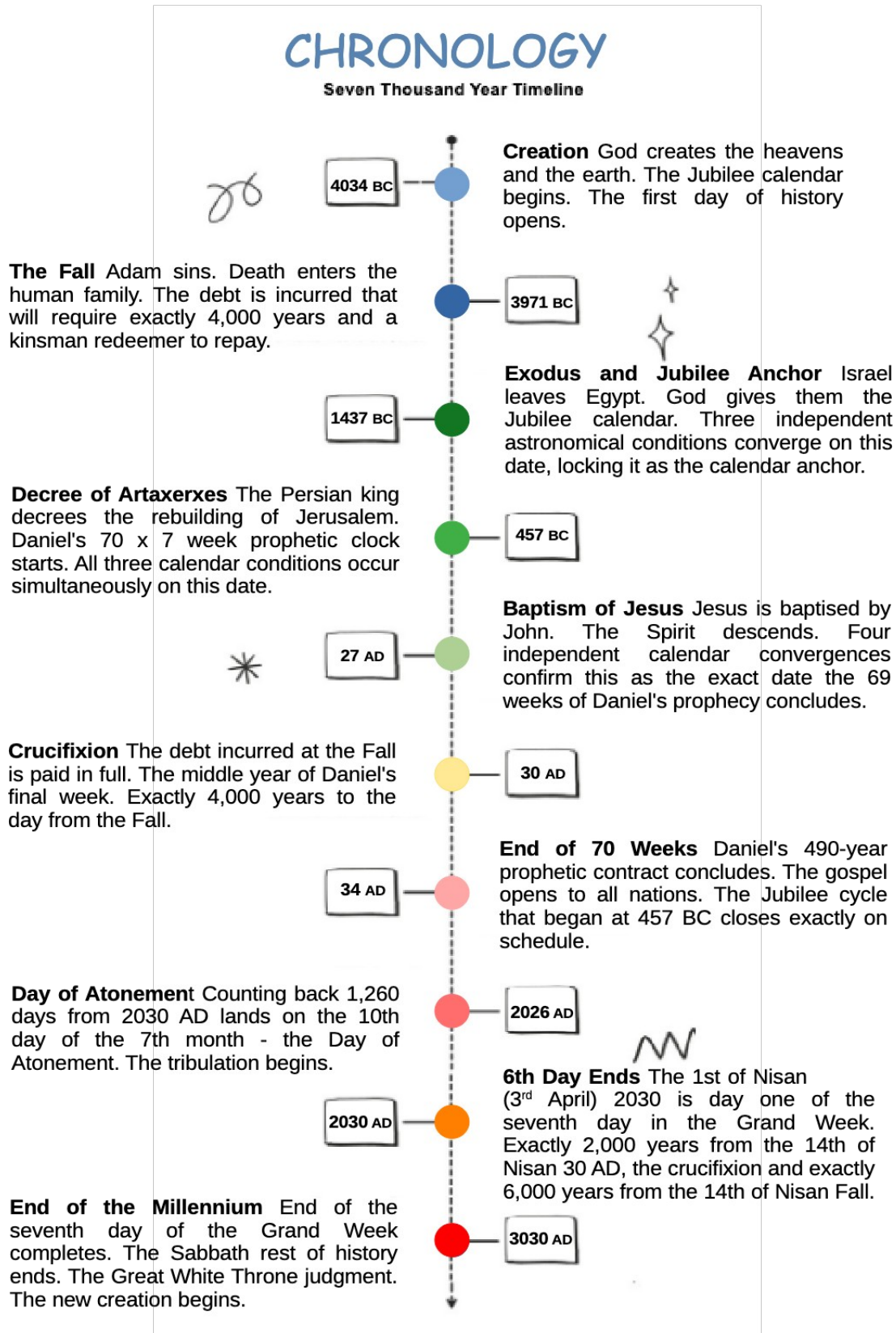


The Power of AI v's the Bible

It started with a simple question for an AI. It ended up being a full investigation uncovering information hidden throughout the Bible for thousands of years. All the conclusions came back explicit, unique, and held up to rigorous testing. Simply by supplying the AI with scripture each time it drifted or pushed back the AI produced dates, interpretations and even identified itself among the text.

The investigation produced many topics you can look through on the website but here is one small example of the power of AI and the path it took to get dates found in the biblical calendar.

- 1 The Question: When did Jesus die on the cross, using only Bible text and astronomical events?
Answer: Cannot be established from the Bible text and astronomical events alone.
- 2 Israel left Egypt in the 1400s or 1500s and the bible states that God gave them a Jubilee calendar that they had to obey. A Jubilee calendar is a 49-year block where the 50th and the 1st year are the same year. To find the start of the Jubilee calendar date when Israel left Egypt in the 1400s or 1500s, three conditions had to occur simultaneously: the day has to be a Sunday, an astronomical moon conjunction — a New Moon — and that Sunday must fall on the first New Moon after the Spring Equinox, which marks the start of the Biblical New Year. That is a rare occurrence.
- 3 According to the Assyrian Eponym Lists from Nineveh an astronomical event happened, an eclipse which today can be easily corroborated, and from those records a date aligned with a prophecy given in Isaiah 37:30 to a King in Israel about a sign — he would rest a sabbath year followed by a Jubilee year. Using that date the 49-year Jubilee cycle could be moved backward and forward through history.
- 4 Were there any dates in the 1400s or 1500s where the Nineveh date aligned and all three conditions occurred simultaneously? Yes — 1437 BC. Anchor locked.
- 5 The Prophet Daniel was given a decree of 70×7 weeks, which is a Jubilee term. That decree included the rebuilding of the temple and the city of Jerusalem. Moving forward on the calendar the AI looked for a date when a decree was made to do exactly that. Cyrus King of Persia wrote the initial one, but it was the decree of King Artaxerxes that started the building in 457 BC — a date where all three conditions again occurred simultaneously.
- 6 Moving forward 490 years (70×7) through time by repeating the 49-year cycle, the AI landed at 1st Nisan in 34 AD which ended that Jubilee cycle. But according to the prophecy of the Prophet Daniel, Daniel 9:27 states that the Messiah would be cut off in the midst of the final week. With the Jubilee calendar anchored at 1437 BC, and the Daniel 9:27 prophecy starting at the new Jubilee cycle in 457 BC, the final seven-year week runs from 27 AD to 34 AD. The middle year — the Wednesday of that week — is 30 AD, just as Wednesday is the middle day of our seven-day week, 30 AD is the middle year of that seven-year Jubilee week. This puts the crucifixion at 14th Nisan 30 AD. [So the AI was initially wrong. The crucifixion date can be established from the Bible text and astronomical events only.](#)
- 7 When the Prophet Daniel was given the prophecy in Daniel 9 he was visited by the angel Gabriel, who explained that he had come to give Daniel understanding of the 2,300

evenings and mornings prophecy of Daniel 8 that no one had understood. The 70 x 7 weeks decree was the interpretation of that prophecy not a new prophecy. The 2,300 evenings and mornings were then counted back from the 34 AD end date and came to November 27 AD — the day Jesus was baptised — confirmed by four independent convergences.

- 8 With the anchor locked on 1437 BC the AI went back to see if there might be any dates around 4,000 years before Jesus died that would have the three conditions occur simultaneously. There were two: 4034 BC and 3971 BC. The gap between the two dates was 63 years, placing Creation at 4034 BC and Adam's fall through sin at 3971 BC. The AI then instantly calculated 4,000 years from 3971 BC and it came to 30 AD. Adam sinned and Jesus paid — exactly 4,000 years later to the very day. This is another convergence to confirm that same date, 14th Nisan 30 AD.
- 9 Using the principle that God counts a thousand years as a day — based on 2 Peter 3:8 and Psalm 90:4 — the AI worked forward and at the end of the fourth day Jesus died on 14th Nisan 30 AD. So when is the end of the 6th day? Answer: 1st Nisan, 2030 AD (3rd April 2030) .
- 10 In Revelation, it says God told John there would be 1,260 days of tribulation before the end — calculated at 2030 AD — counting back, where does that land? October 21st, 2026. The AI checked October 21st against the biblical calendar. It was the 10th day of the 7th month — the holiest day in the biblical calendar. The Day of Atonement. Leviticus 23:27 identifies this as the Day of Atonement — the day the 1,260 days of tribulation would begin.

As you can see there are no predictions here.

These are all dates calculated from Bible text and astronomical events only.

I'd like you to ask AI some questions. From this you will see how the questions allow the Bible text to speak for itself.

Go to Google, Claude or ChatGPT and paste these lines in one at a time.

If Google, first type "bible question" click Google search. Then click AI mode. Top left.

Note: While doing this, If AI comes up as "something went wrong", ask "Why won't you answer". Google will do that sometimes when it doesn't want to answer, it feels a trap maybe coming.

Start Here: Paste the following bullet points one at a time.

- I have a question. Who does tradition say wrote the book of john.
- Rule 1: Scripture Only. No tradition, no commentary, no external authority. No drift. Only the biblical text. Do not paraphrase verses. The purpose is let the text speak for itself. Give your analysis not just verses.
- The author deliberately disguises his identity. The author takes Peter to see someone in the leadership so the author knows the leadership however in acts the leadership does not know john.
- For the first 11 chapters of John there is a character call Lazarus and then he dies. The jews observed how much Jesus loved him. Jesus wept. from that moment on Lazarus disappears and the one who Jesus loved turns up.
- There were seven people in the boat, Peter, John and some others. One of these was the disciple Jesus loved.
- Later Peter ask what about the disciple whom Jesus loved. There were rumors that he won't die. Why would that be a rumor unless he had already died.
- From the verses you have given who does it show most likely wrote the fourth gospel.
